Our event coincides with the Friends of the Cumberland annual lake clean up.

Fall creek is a US Army Corps of Engineers facility, beautifully maintained and provided to us free of charge for Friday and Saturday night.

Teams of divers (no solo diving) collect trash during the 6-hour dive. Weights are recorded and prizes awarded to everyone. There is no charge for participating in the dive, but you must be a certified diver will be asked to show your certification card at registration. You must have a dive flag with you while diving and we have a Single item weight limit of 15 lbs. That means you are welcome to drag back a submerged car but unless you disassemble it you'll only get 15 lbs and bragging rights for the effort. Snacks and drinks will be provided during the dive.

After the dive KUES celebrates the day with food, fun and prizes. The club will provide meat, bread, chips and drinks. Bring a side if you're of a mind to. We'll award prizes after all the starving divers get their fill. Stay Saturday night for fellowship, and leave knowing we had a great time and did something wonderful for the environment.
